### Full Season Middle School Volleyball

The YMCA will again run a full season middle school volleyball program for girls in the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Registration starts in August with a deadline of Monday, September 13<sup>th</sup> with a coaches meeting on Sep. 15<sup>th</sup>. Players can sign up individually or as a team but the fee is still \$100.00 per player. A team must have at least 8 players. Games are played mostly on Saturdays with a few Sundays starting Sept. 25<sup>th</sup> and ending November 6<sup>th</sup>. The 14 game season will play at Madison MS. Practices will be in local middle schools and will start Monday, September 20<sup>th</sup>. Registration forms are available in the lobby of the YMCA or online at eugeneymca.org.
